## OTA2039: Level I Fieldwork for Children and Adolescents

Towards the end of the quarter in which students take <u>OTA2031</u> Occupational Therapy for Children and Adolescents, students will be placed on a Level I Fieldwork experience for 24-35 hours that offers students an opportunity to observe and assist practitioners and/or staff working with typical and atypical children and adolescents. Student will observe client assessment and intervention, as appropriate, and learn about issues impacting holistic pediatric occupational therapy practice. The Level I Fieldwork experience provides opportunities to apply academic course preparation to practice settings working with children and adolescents. This course is Pass/Fail (P/F).
