CRJ4995: Criminal Justice Internship I

The internship/practicum program within South University's Department of Criminal Justice is designed specifically to enable the student to apply classroom knowledge to the work environment, and to better prepare the graduate to seek entry-level employment in the criminal justice field. It will expose the student to the qualifications and requirements of various employing agencies and give him or her experience to meet those requirements.
